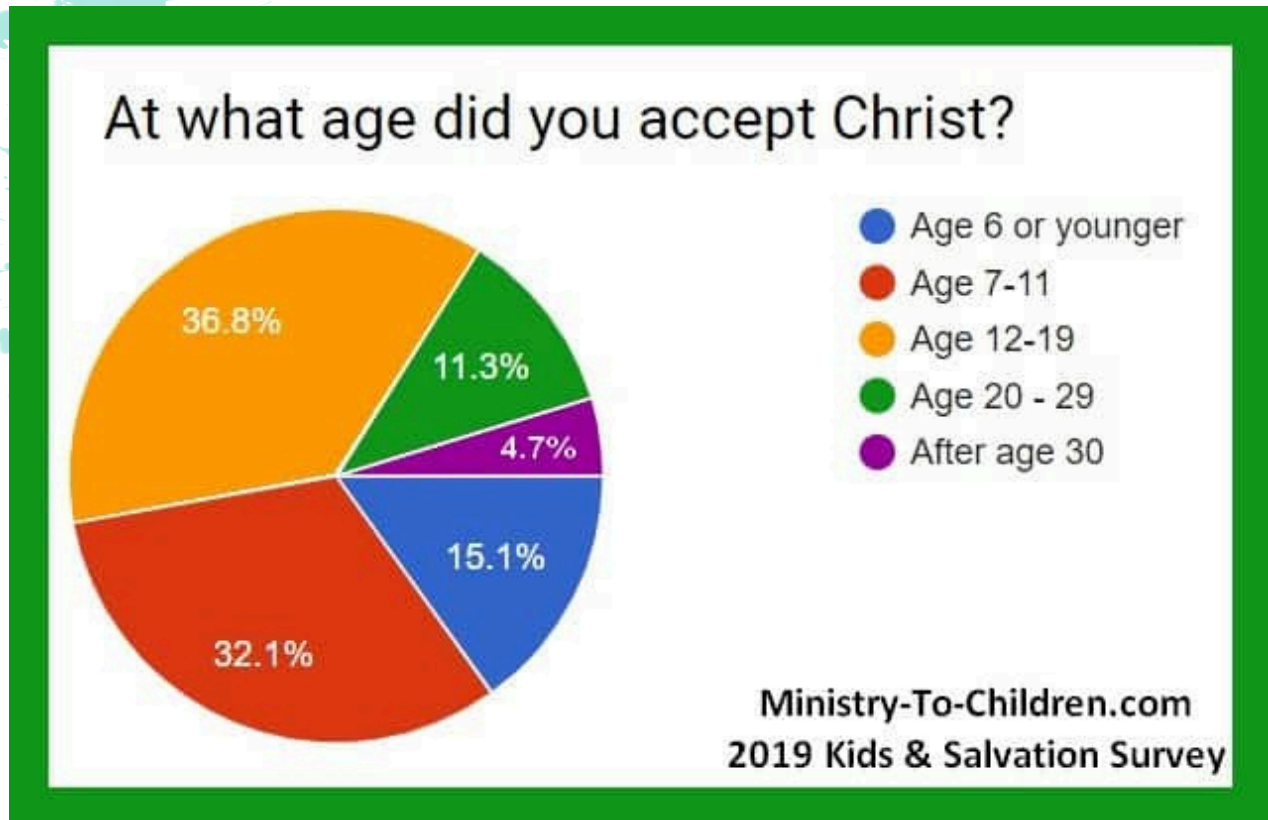

Why is Outreach Vital?



Surveys say that only one fourth of believers come to Christ after the age of 21.

This is a staggering reality we must face.

Let's make evangelism a primary goal in our churches, children's ministries and outreaches.

Ask God for your strategy as you partner with Him for the sake of the Gospel.

This resource will help you train, prepare and launch an outreach team.

Who Is This Resource For?

Churches, bible study groups, and believers confident in sharing the gospel. Even if you're not confident, don't worry - videos to help you are down below!

For this outreach experience, your team needs
at least 10-12 volunteers.

Post leaders/volunteers at each table to ensure the efficiency and safety of the activities.

Plan for 2-3 hours for your outreach and allow extra time to set up/clean up. You may choose a park, a church parking lot, the beach, or anywhere you are allowed to set up your tables and enjoy the community grounds freely.

Note to the Outreach Leader:

Prepare your volunteers to engage the community kids/adults/teens with the Gospel.

Watch this [video resource](#) for learning a simple method of sharing the gospel through "3 Circles."

It only takes 3-4 minutes to share this with someone.

During your outreach prep you can train your volunteers to share the gospel with this video.

"3 Circles" is very reproducible and can be very effective.

Be sure to practice how to lead someone to Christ after the 3 Circles are shared.

Here is a more descriptive video about the 3 Circles method with follow-up questions.

Materials Needed for your first outreach at the park:

1) Hotdog Serving Area 🍔 🔥

- 2-3 sturdy 6-ft tables (or 2 large folding table)
- Pop-up canopy or shade (unless your park has a pavillion)(optional but helpful)
- A sign that says "FREE HOTDOGS, WATER, PRAYER"
(included in this kit, to print and laminate, for a volunteer to hold for cars driving by or post/tape to your table)
- About 150 hotdogs, buns, large ketchup and mustard, paper boats, 1 paper towel roll, 2 trash bags
- 2 coolers with ice: one for cold food and one filled with water bottles and ice
- Serving equipment: Small grill, pan with a lid for cooked hotdogs to stay hot, tongs and food service gloves to serve them with
- Individually wrapped snacks to pass out: chips, fruit-snacks, cookies
- First aid kit

Volunteers needed for serving:

- 2- 3 volunteers for food tables, grilling hotdogs, etc
- 2 outgoing volunteers greeting and guiding and helping participants
- 2-4 volunteers inviting and talking to passersby and park goers
- 2 prayer partner volunteers, to be available to talk to and pray with participants

2) Face-Painting Table 🎨🖌️

- Paint set (non-toxic and water-based) and extra brushes and sponges
- 1 Table and chairs, or a picnic table
- Mirror for the children to see the artwork
- Table cover
- Baby wipes
- Containers with water for washing brushes
- Sanitizing wipes and hand sanitizer
- 2-3 Volunteers needed

Designate 1 main artist and 1-2 helper volunteers.

Go-to simple designs: butterfly, kitty, superhero mask, paw print, rainbow, lion and tiger face, fire

For your first time, I suggest you practice and watch Youtube videos to learn how to do face-painting well.

3) Games & Outdoor Activities (Budget-Friendly) 🏃 ⚽

4-6 Volunteers needed to organize games

- Equipment (multi-use and borrow-friendly)
- Jumping/throwing gear:
- 4-6 balls (soccer, kickball, dodgeball),
- 4-6 frisbees
- Activity props: 6-8 hula hoops, 12-20 bean bags
- Cones for marking lanes and stations (20+)
- Chalk for drawings/field games (large sidewalk chalk)
- Chalk and mark off your gaming areas if possible

Game ideas:

(some are linked to Amazon for easy purchase)

- Ring toss Ages 3-10
- Obstacle course (timed or fun) Ages 3-5
- Water sponge relay Ages 6-10
- Capture the flag (bandanas) Ages 9-12

Prizes & give-aways:

- Stickers
- fruit-snacks
- bubbles
- fidget soccer balls,
- fidget spinner 100ct

Please consider:

- Safety & supervision
- Hydration station (water + cups)
- Shade area, bug spray and sunscreen
- First aid kit on-site
- Sufficient adult supervision per activity (ratio depends on age)
- Clear boundary rules and emergency plan

4) The BIBLE Table

Let's not forget the most important part and the reason you are on outreach in your community!

- 2-3 Volunteers need to be stationed at the table Introduce yourself and say this "Everything you see here is free, do you have a Bible at home? Would you like one today? Would you like to pick out a bracelet?" "Can I pray for you today?" If the person seems lost, ask "Can I share the gospel with you through the 3 Circles?"
- Learn the "3 Circles" for kids and practice on one another before the day of your outreach
- 1 6ft folding table
- Stretchy black table cover
- "Jesus Loves You" Bracelets
- Bible Tracts to help you share the Gospel
- Bibles and devotionals for kids/teens/adults (You can collect these from your local resale store and ask for these donated books from your church.)
- Cover your outreach in prayer every day before as a part of preparation.

Your prayer may sound like mine but use your own words!

Lord God, would you prepare my heart to be a vessel for your glory. Please use me for your Kingdom purposes and let me be a light that shines in the darkness. Will you bring to the outreach those who need to know you, need encouragement and community to surround them with your love? We dedicate this time and these resources for You. Have you way, Holy Spirit. In Jesus Name, Amen.

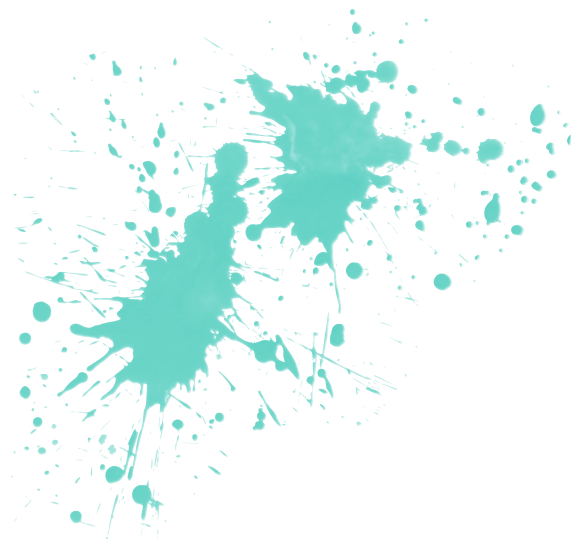

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Closing Thoughts about Following-up!

You may be wondering about what happens after an outreach! Here are some ideas for following up with your new friends.

- Actually get to know people! Learn their name, hear a little about their life, and (if they're comfortable) get contact information for following up.
- Try to follow up within a few days. A simple text checking in and asking how they're doing can make a huge impact.
- Create a care team. Have church members whose role is to maintain connections through texts, calls, prayer, acts of service, and encouragement.
- Invite people into further friendship to things like potlucks, game nights, small groups, service projects, and even meeting up for coffee often help people connect more naturally.
- Provide clear next steps. For example: Outreach → Follow up → Community Event → Small Group/Bible Study → Church Involvement.

Note: Try not to be too pushy about these. Mention them, and if interest is expressed, give specific dates & times.

- Pair individuals who are interested in faith with specific church members. Having someone who knows them, checks in regularly, and walks alongside them helps them feel they truly belong.
- Continue serving practical needs when possible. This shows that the church cares beyond a single event!
